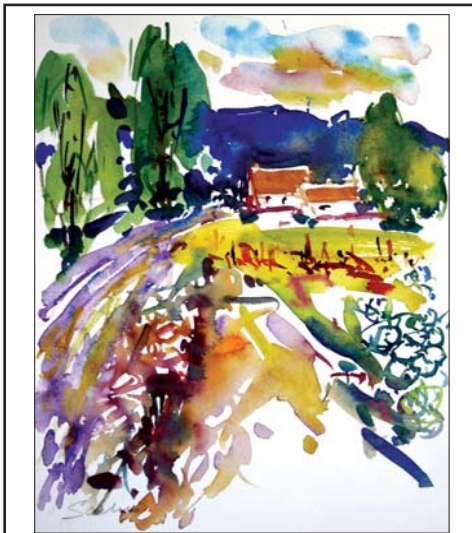


Sketch (68), 10x13 inches, Ink



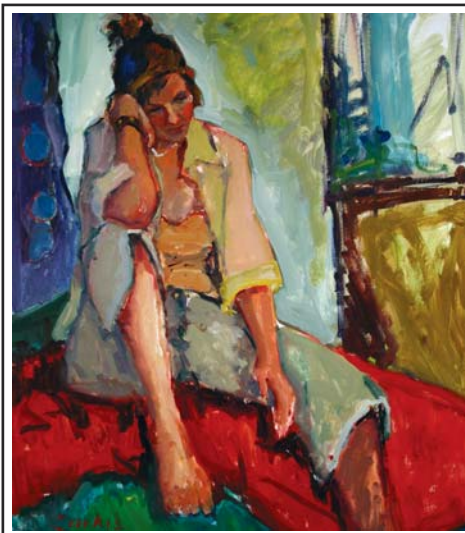

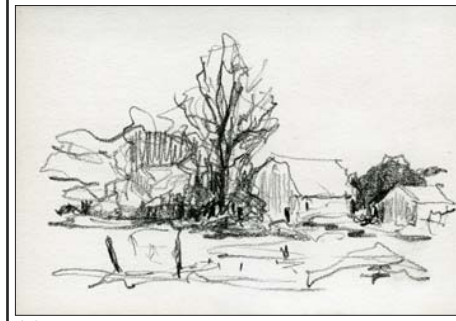


Thoughtful, 40x32 inches, Oil

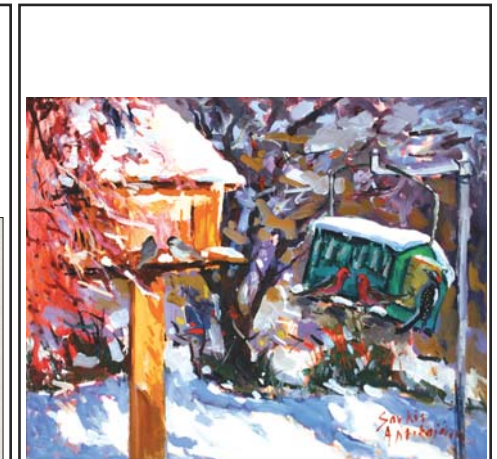


Rose Bushes, 32x40 inches, Oil
